## **IDA Awards Winnipeg's West End Business Improvement Zone Top Honor**

**Winnipeg, MB** – The **International Downtown Association (IDA)** recognized 65 urban innovators as winners of the **Downtown Achievement Awards** which identify outstanding improvements to urban centers by dedicated organizations around the globe. The winning organizations represent nearly 50 cities in the U.S., Canada, and South Africa. The winning projects are selected from six categories, including: downtown leadership and management; economic and business development; events and programming; marketing and communications; planning; and public space. The awards were presented at the 63<sup>rd</sup> Annual IDA Conference & Tradeshow held in Winnipeg September 13-15 this year.

**The top five projects received *Pinnacle Awards*, the industry's highest honor. The West End Business Improvement Zone (West End BIZ) was presented with a Pinnacle award in the Economic Development category for their *Open for Business* project.**
